FEMA's Risk Mapping, Assessment, and Planning (Risk MAP) Program has provided funding to the Illinois State Water Survey to convert the Peoria County Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) into a continuous, digital, countywide format with all communities being mapped. As part of the project FEMA has funded outreach activities that facilitate greater community engagement at multiple milestones in the process with the last planned meeting occurring after Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps are released.
